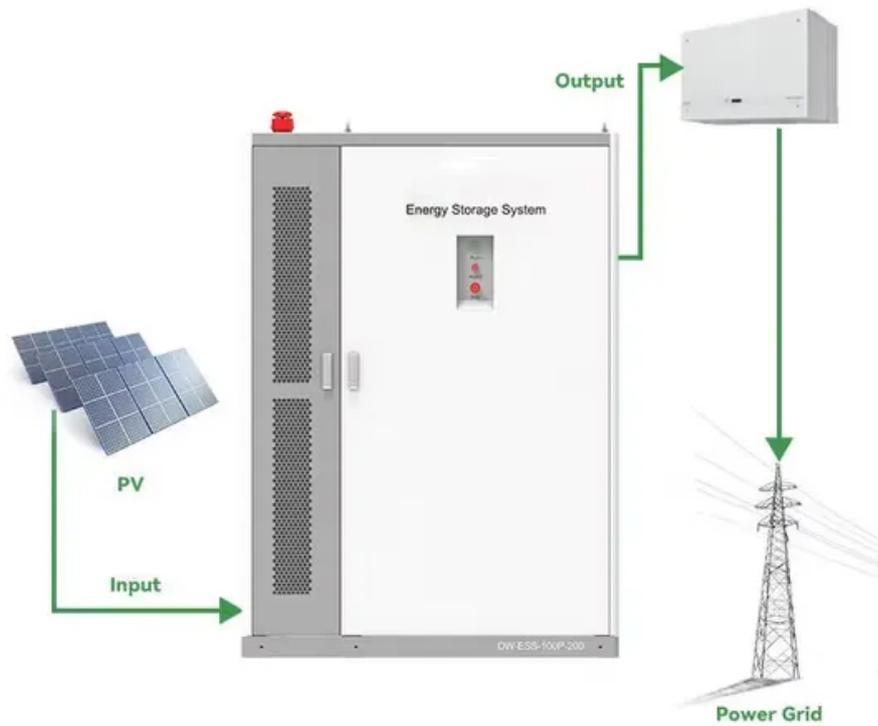


How to open the factory solar container battery cabinet
