The plant project is named Talnique Solar and is located in the town of Talnique in the La Libertad department. It will feature 29,600 bifacial solar panels. CEL's subsidiary Inversiones Energeticas (INE) is executing the project with an investment of USD 20 million (EUR 20.6 million, according to data from the Ministry of Housing). Between 2015 and 2023, El Salvador experienced a 160-fold increase in its solar energy generation capacity, according to statistics from the Latin American Energy.
