In photovoltaic system design, the spacing between solar panels is a key factor that directly affects system performance, including light reception, heat dissipation, and maintenance convenience. Solar altitude depends on latitude, tilt, and solar declination for the selected date. The spacing between the rows from each other are determined using the calculations for the angle of incidence of solar radiation for December 23, when the sun is lowest above the horizon. The selection of this distance is closely related to our geographical location, as well as the.
